What is involved in the project?

Beginning in June 2019, work is due to commence on the R125 Rathbeale Road Upgrade Project involving the:

- Upgrade of the existing R125 Rathbeale Road from the Murrough Road Junction to the new Oldtown/Mooretown Junction.
- Provision of new high-quality pedestrian/ cyclist facilities, signalised junctions, pedestrian crossings and reduction of the speed limit from 80kmph to 50kmph
- Extensive upgrade and replacement of existing utilities, surface water drainage and foul sewers

Outline Programme of Works

- **Single Lane Closures** under traffic lights to facilitate Site Clearance and initial Water/Gas relocation – **June 2019 to August 2019**
- **Road Closure:** To allow deep drainage installation, new pavements, services installations and culvert extension works - **August 2019 to December 2019**
- **Single Lane Closures** under traffic lights to complete works: **January 2020 – May 2020**

R125 Rathbeale Road Closure

- The road will be closed from the Oldtown/Mooretown Junction to the Murrough Road Junction from August 2019 into December 2019. (Highlighted Blue on map overleaf)
- Traffic will be diverted off the R125 Rathbeale Road via a temporary link road onto the Castlevue Extension, onto the Glen Ellan Road and back to Murrough Road Junction.
- Routes for Swords (Purple) and Ashbourne (Orange) bound traffic are highlighted in the map overleaf.
- A statutory Road Closure Notice will be placed in the relevant papers mid-July with a consultation period whereby the public will have a chance to submit observations online from 16th July 2019 at <https://consult.fingal.ie/en/browse>

What arrangements have been made to minimise disruption?

- A temporary Drop-off/Pick-up carpark will be constructed west of the School Campus, in order facilitate vehicles that would normally park on Castlevue Extension.
- Advance warning signage will be placed throughout the local and greater area to advise motorists of disruption on the R125 Rathbeale Road and to use alternative routes
- The Bus stop on Rathbeale Road at Cianlea will be closed, with alternative arrangements made on Glen Ellan Road
- Bus stops at Rathbeale Cottages will remain operational as normal
- As of the beginning of June 2019, the R125 Rathbeale Road speed limit has been reduced to 50kmph between Rathbeale Cottages and the Murrough Road Junction
- Gardai and Emergency Services have been notified of the works
- Local access for residents and the House of Worship on Rathbeale Road will be maintained at all times
- Traffic Flows will be assessed at Murrough Road Junction and the traffic lights will be adjusted as necessary to accommodate diversion traffic.

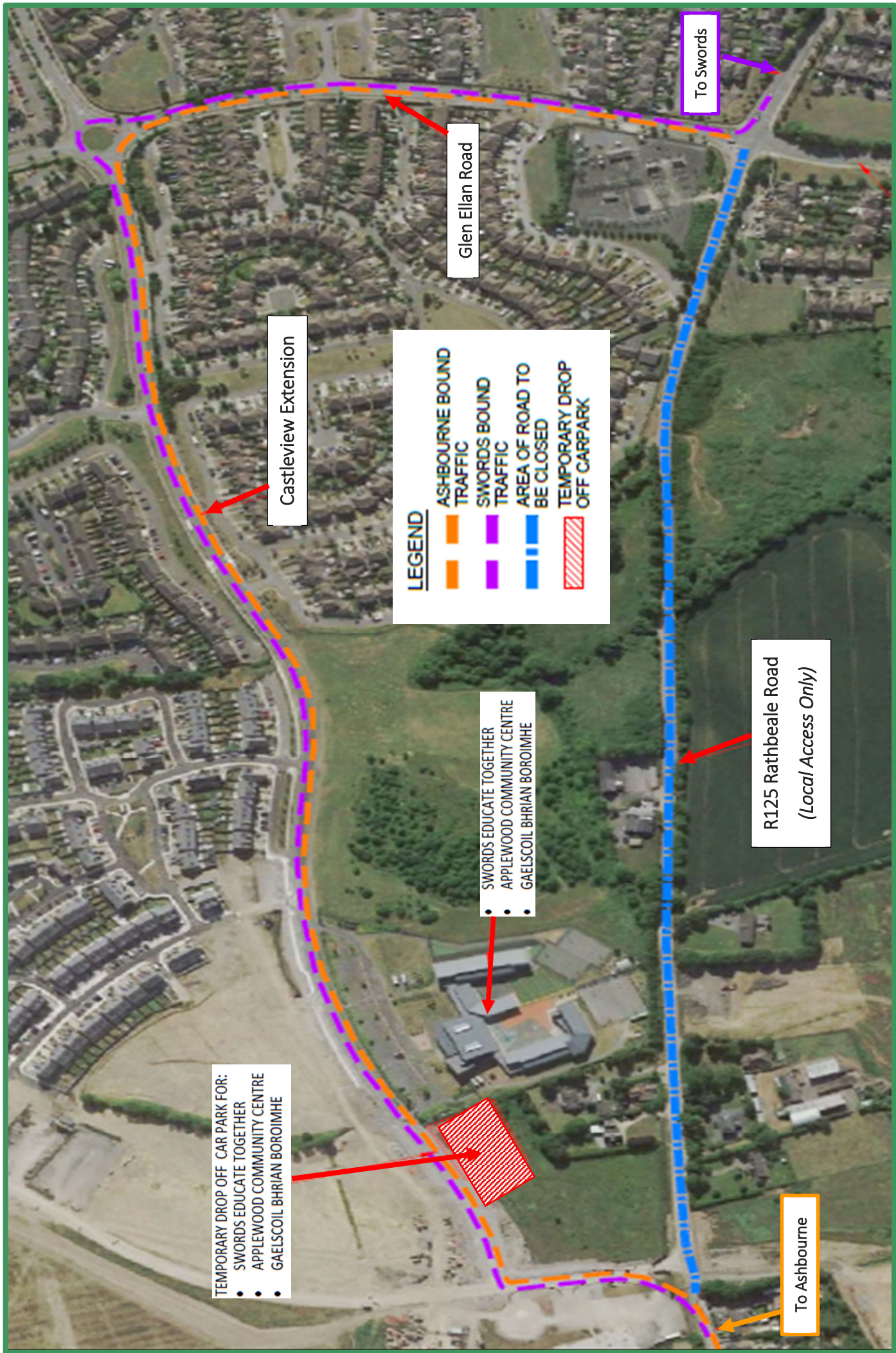
